REQUIREMENTS TO JOIN THE YOUTH CLIMATE ACTION FUND PROGRAMME

- Detailed description of the proposed project.
- Budget showing how the funds will be utilized.
- Eligible applicants must have formal incorporation or status, a bank account in their name, and the ability to manage the funds.
- Projects must align with the Accra Climate Action Plan (CAP).
- Funds must be used for the purposes outlined in the approved application.
- Projects must be completed with all funds spent by December 31st, 2024.

PROGRAMME DETAILS

- **Programme Timeline:** The programme will run for the next six months, providing you with the resources and support needed to implement climate action projects in our city.
