A penalty will be charged on defaulters as specified in the Local Government Act 936, section 181 clause 1,2a and 2b which states that, ***“A District Assembly may make by-laws for the purpose of any function conferred on that District Assembly by this Act or any other enactment.”***

Property owners are to note that, A.M.A. collectors would be working during early hours of the day and on weekends to ensure that all monies owed the assembly are collected.

Additionally, rate payers are requested to support this very important exercise to enable the Assembly carry out its metropolitan duties.
