AMA TO BEGIN SPECIAL REVENUE MOBILISATION EXERCISE ON MONDAY

The Accra Metropolitan Assembly (AMA) wishes to inform all businesses, property owners, and outdoor advertising companies operating within the metropolis that it will commence a massive revenue mobilisation exercise on **Monday**, **10th November**, **2025** to retrieve all monies owed to the Assembly for the 2025 fiscal year.

The exercise, which forms part of efforts to improve revenue generation and enhance service delivery across the city, will involve the deployment of a Revenue Mobilisation Task Force to visit business premises, properties, and advertising locations to reconcile bills and collect outstanding payments.

Towards this end, all ratepayers are required to make available valid receipts of payment covering Business Operating Permits (BOPs), Property Rates, and Outdoor Advertising Fees, and Rents for verification by leaving their receipts with caretakers when not available, to avoid penalties as no excuses will be accepted from defaulters or their agents.

The operation will also target all unauthorised billboards, which will be removed by the task force. Companies found to have erected such billboards without the requisite permits will be surcharged with the cost of removal.

The Assembly urge all ratepayers to support this important exercise, as the funds collected will enable the AMA to continue delivering essential services such as sanitation, infrastructure development, and public safety for the benefit of all residents of Accra.
