INDISCRIMINATE SPRINGING OF BUILDINGS AT CHORKOR

I therefore humbly request the PRCC to look into this matter with urgency by embarking on a public sensitization program to educate the indigenes of Chorkor on the need for them to acquire permit before putting up buildings. The PRCC should also summon owners of this structure and require them to stop building.
